



DEVELOPMENTAL SUPPORTS

In the Calgary Zone, access to Occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy or Speech Therapy services for developmental and/or medical conditions is through the Pediatric Community Rehabilitation program.

Services are generally offered for children 0-5 years old.

Services are also offered to youth ages 6-18 if there is a significant change in their medical or developmental condition, injury, surgery, illness or medical intervention.

Sessions may be group based or 1:1. They may be provided by zoom, phone or in person.

Occupational Therapy 0-18 years services children and their families with self - care;

- motor development
- self - care
- participation in activities typical for their development
- eating, feeding and swallowing
- modifying the environment
- assistive technology
- mobility and positioning equipment

Physiotherapy 0-18 years services children and their families with development and movement.

- motor development
- movement and function
- torticollis
- mobility and positioning equipment

Speech Language Pathology 0-18 years services children and their families with:

- communication
- pronouncing speech sounds
- understanding and listening to spoken language (0-5 years only)
- using words to communicate thoughts and ideas (0-5 years only)
- speaking smoothly and easily (stuttering)
- eating, feeding and swallowing
- using gestures, pictures, communication boards to communicate (augmentative & alternative communication, AAC)
